Mammon is a spiritual ruler over money, finances, and other resources. He enslaves people with fear and greed. He is opposed to God and demands allegiance from people. Jesus declared: "You cannot serve God and Mammon." (Mt 6:24).

Symptoms

- "I'm not worthwhile."
 - o I'll have to do without.
 - I don't deserve any better.
- "There is never enough."
 - Excess accumulation (from preparation to hoarding).
 - o Comparisons, Cheap, Lack of generosity.
- "I must provide for myself."
 - Slave to an income source.
 - My value is measured by my income or accumulations.
