Solid Foundation

Equip the saints, build up the body, attain unity, knowledge, maturity, and the fullness of Christ (Eph 4:11-14)

- **Apostle:** One who has been set apart, appointed by God, to act as an ambassador of the Gospel and to act as a testimony for the truth.
 - Initiator, organizer, visionary.
- **Prophet:** Speaking the Word of God to a group or individual.
 - Truth-teller, Godly guidance.
- **Evangelist:** Able to share the gospel with unbelievers in such a way that the unbeliever becomes a disciple of the Lord Jesus.
 - Vision sharing, outreach, expansion.
- **Pastor:** The shepherd of a flock. Someone who guides, feeds, nurtures, protects, and oversees a group.
 - Safety, comfort, faith, mentoring.
- **Teacher:** Able to understand and communicate the truths of God in a way that allows others to learn; to impart knowledge or provide explanation.
 - Guidance, confidence, support.
