## SOP: The Fear of the Lord

While **consecration** is a posture of humility and devotion, the **fear of the Lord** is a condition of the heart that allows a person to be always living and walking by the Spirit.

**Definition**: To live and be in reverent awe of God's holiness; to give Him complete reverence and honor as the God of glory, majesty, purity and power.

- It is a powerful spiritual truth and posture that sets us free from pleasing the world—satisfying all of its' whims and the pressure of the culture, and is an accurate response to His Presence and power.
- It is to desire to live in harmony with His righteous standards and honor Him in all that you say and do.
- It is to walk in the Presence of a Holy, Just, Almighty God—with no personal reputation or means to approach but for the sacrifice of the Cross.
- It is knowing Who God is—and treating Him appropriately.
- It is to say every word, think every thought, and take every action in light of being the temple—the habitation of the Living God.
