SOP: The Practice of Patience

Demonstrated toward us—it is the Nature of God

- God is Creator/Designer (He knows how long it takes for someone or something to come to maturity (It takes 22-60 days for radishes to grow from seed to harvest. An oak tree typically reaches maturity and starts producing acorns when it's around 30-40 years old)
- When God answers prayer, we often receive His answer in seed form. Some of us are
 expecting fruit, so we don't realize He has already given us His answer—and we need to
 learn to be gardeners.
- Faith is the pregnancy of God's Word /promises in our heart—patience is required to navigate the period of gestation—so that our faith might bear its' fruit.
